



TRC BOARD OF DIRECTOR REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your interest in applying to be on the Tennessee Recycling Coalition (TRC) board. TRC has been promoting and educating recycling in Tennessee for the past 35 years. We have worked in partnership with several organizations to advance recycling in the state, and we are now stronger than ever before. We are excited about the growth of recycling in Tennessee and are committed to continuing our mission of aiding in partnering, education, and development of recycling infrastructure across the state. As we continue to evolve, we are currently seeking applicants to join our board. Please note that TRC is a 12-board organization, and the Executive Director and Past President positions are not included in the board of 12.

The board consists of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary. Regardless of the title, this is a working board. TRC does not hold many advisory roles and is looking for members willing to put in a little time and effort to grow our organization.

Some of the responsibilities include:

- Monthly Board Calls
- Annual Board meeting, in February of every year.
- Annual TRC Conference, in August of every year.
- Active in planning, participating, and working during the TRC conference.
- Active in raising sponsorship and exhibitors to the conference.
- Active in workshops, newsletters, and other board activities.

A few other requirements include:

- Must be a resident of the State of Tennessee.
- Must be passionate about recycling.
- Must be willing to work with a team to aid in education and outreach for recycling programming.

TRC typically tries to select board members with the following considerations:

- Ideally like to have board members from different areas in the state.
- Ideally like to have a diverse group of board members ranging from solid waste directors, to industry professionals, to recyclers, to state and local government and nonprofits.
- Ideally look to have a wide array of experience and willingness to aid in TRC responsibilities
